- Children will be encouraged to name different animals and birds.

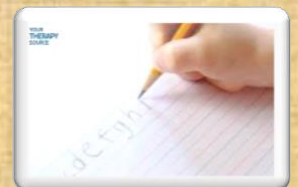

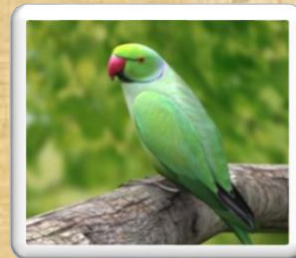

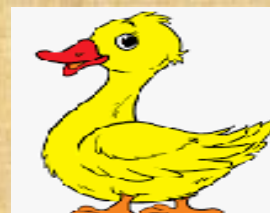
