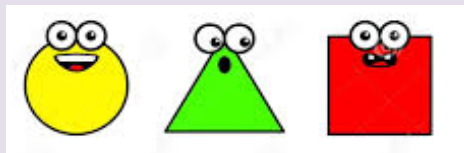
- ★ **Integrated activity Book** - Page No. 34 to 39
